

Mathematical skills and development

Year 2

As mathematicians, we will be continuing with addition and subtraction and then moving onto multiplication and division. The children will be continuing with the Mastering Number skills and using these in daily lessons.

Year 3

As mathematicians, we will be continuing with addition and subtraction and then moving onto the units of multiplication and division and fractions. The children will be continuing to use Times Table Rockstars both in school and encouraged at home, as this will provide them with vital multiplication and division fact knowledge.

Music

As musicians, we will be learning how to play a glockenspiel. We Will learn about notation, playing together, listening and then improvising around a theme.

English skills and development

As creative writer's, we will be focusing on writing using a variety of punctuation at the end of sentences, paragraphing and fronted adverbials. We will also be including ambitious vocabulary in our talk as well as writing. We will be learning about non-fiction texts, poetry linked to the weather and fiction writing based on the loved children's book Flat Stanley.

As language learners, we will be learning Spanish words for the body parts and colours.

Science

As scientists, we will be investigating why animals, including humans need the right type and amount of nutrition.

Later in the term, we will focus on animal habitats and why an animal's habitat is key to their survival.
