English skills and development.

In phonics we continue to follow the Bug Club Phonic scheme of work, the focus will be to apply our knowledge of phase 3 sounds and irregular words to our reading and writing and reading and writing words containing consinent clusters and of more than one syllable.

As creative writers, we will be using a variety of texts, both fiction, non-fiction and poetry which will link with our themes; possible texts include; Daisy Doodles, The Train Ride, Naughty Bus, Grow your Own Lettuce and Little Red Riding Hood.
